



Alsace Region Wine Experiences

Discover the beautiful Alsace Wine Route (Route des Vins d'Alsace). The 105-mile (170-km) stretch of road snakes through the bright-green foothills of the Vosges mountains and features hundreds of Alsace's prized vineyards. Most tours to the region begin in Strasbourg.

Here are a few ideas of what you can experience in the Alsace Region

Day Trip to the Alsace Wine Route – 8 Hours

From Strasbourg: Get the full experience of the famous French wine region of Alsace on this wine-tasting day trip from Strasbourg. With an informative guide, travel along the gorgeous Alsace Wine Route to the picture-perfect towns of Mittelbergheim, Dambach-la-Ville, Ribeauvillé and Riquewihr. Visit four wineries to enjoy tastings of the region's characteristic white wine including the Riesling and gewürztraminer varietals. Numbers are limited to eight people on this small-group tour, ensuring a more personalized wine-tasting experience.

Half-Day Trip to the Alsace Wine Route – 4 Hours

From Strasbourg: Let an expert guide introduce you to the Alsace region's world-renowned wine on this half-day wine tour from Strasbourg. Traveling along the famous Alsace Wine Route, stop in two picturesque Alsatian towns to enjoy tastings of the area's celebrated white wine, such as Riesling and gewürztraminer. Choose a morning or afternoon tour to suit your schedule. Numbers are limited to eight people on this small-group tour, ensuring a more personalized wine-tasting experience.

Full Day Tour of the Alsace – 9 Hours

From Strasbourg: Immerse yourself in the quaint villages and beautiful scenery of Alsace on this full-day tour from Strasbourg. With your expert guide, drive through rolling, vine-coated hills to explore the picturebook town of Colmar and cobbled village of Eguisheim. Then, delve into the medieval, walled village of Riquewihr and follow the famous Alsace Wine Route where you will enjoy a wine-tasting session at one of the wineries along the way. Continue to your last stop at the fairytale-like, 12th-century fortress of High Koenigsbourg. Numbers are limited to eight people on this small-group tour, so you can enjoy an in-depth experience.
