Here are a few ideas of what you can experience in the Champagne Region

Day Trip to Reims and Epernay with 2 Tasting Sessions – 10.5 Hours

From Paris: Enjoy a glass of bubbly as you spend a day in the famous region of Champagne on a day trip from Paris. With its magnificent vineyards, impressive heritage and world class champagnes, the region makes a great excursion from the French capital. Explore the Mercier cellars in Epernay. Also visit the Mumm Champagne House and Reims Cathedral.

Visit the Chandon and Moët Champagne Houses – 10.5 Hours

From Paris: This tour will take you to the heart of the Champagne country to discover the history and secrets of "The King of Wines". You'll visit world-renowned champagne house of Moët and Chandon and tour the historic city of Reims, the capital of the Champagne region. Numbers are limited to a maximum of 8 people on this small group tour, ensuring you'll receive personalized attention from your guide.

Visit Epernay and Hautvilliers – 12 Hours

From Paris: Enjoy a wonderful day trip from Paris to Champagne, one of the most famous regions in France, and indulge in eight tastings of bubbly in three different locations! With your expert guide, a trained sommelier, visit Moët & Chandon in the town of Epernay for your first tasting. Then visit the village of Hautvilliers, the home of the monk Dom Pérignon and the birth place of Champagne, before enjoying more Champagne and a French lunch of cheese and charcuterie at a small boutique winery. Finish with another tasting in the Premier Crus area. Groups are limited to eight passengers, ensuring a personalized experience.

Private Tour of Moët, Chandon, Hautvillers and the House of Mumm – 10 Hours

From Paris: Head to the home of Champagne on a full-day private tour from Paris that includes samples galore! With a knowledgeable guide, passionate about fine wines and Champagne, you'll tour the ultra-chic Moët and Chandon Champagne cellars in Epernay, learning all about the production of its exceptional sparkling wine. Plus visit the village of Hautvilliers, known for being the hometown of Dom Pérignon, and explore the House of Mumm Champagne cellars in Reims.
